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Citizens'/Clients' Charter

Vision

To enhance productivity and production of Cotton, to fulfill Cotton demand of the Nation and also to make Cotton farming sustainable and profitable for the farming community.

Mission

Enhancing Cotton production and improving income level of all farmers by successful implementation of various new initiatives and Centrally Sponsored Crop Development Schemes, such as, Food and Nutrition Security [(erstwhile National Food Security Mission (NFSM)], Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) etc in various implementing states and effective coordination & monitoring of such schemes.

Objectives

The main objective is to assist the Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Govt. of India to plan, coordinate and monitor nodal crop development programme at the National level and Centrally Sponsored Crop development programmes in Assigned States (Maharashtra & Goa) and recommend measures to improve them.

Functions of the Directorate:

- To plan, Coordinate and monitor nodal commodity (crops) development programmes i.e. Food and Nutrition Security (FNS)- Commercial Crops (Cotton) at the National level and coordinating the efforts to formulate and implement Crop Development programmes for other states/UTs and recommend measure to improve them;
- 2. To monitor Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) viz. Food & Nutrition Security (FNS (Krishionnati Yojana)–Rice, Pulses, Wheat, Nutri Cereals, Coarse Cereals, Commercial Crops- Cotton & Sugarcane in assigned states of Maharashtra and Food & Nutrition Security FNS (Krishionnati Yojana)–Pulses in Goa.
- 3. To monitor CSS NMEO- Oilseeds and Tree Borne Oilseeds (TBOs) in Maharashtra and NMEO-Oilseeds in Goa state.
- 4. To liaise with the other Central Ministries ICAR institutes, SAUs, International Research Organizations, NGOs and other stake holders in the field of Agri. and allied sectors for better Research-Development interface. Also represent Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare and on their Committee/ events with a view to have direct interface for onward benefits to formulate farmer friendly schemes at national level with a unified approach for the overall development of agriculture sector as a whole;
- 5. To have closer interaction/coordination with the Project Directorates / Institutes / SAUs / KVKs and other Research Centres of the ICAR and represent;
- 6. Built data base and maintain the flow of information and ideas between research and development;

- 7. To provide technical support to the Extension agencies with respect to the nodal crop as and when required. To participate in the State Level Crop Training Programmes; Developing leaflets/ Literatures on training manuals;
- 8. To provide crop specific advisories technical inputs to extension agencies and to Extension Division of the Ministry of Agriculture for skill development, national policies and for the Plan year.
- 9. To represent the Varietal Identification Committee (VIC) on Cotton and evaluate the performance of the newly evolved/ released cotton varieties;
- 10. To study and analyze trends in weather, crop area, production and productivity of Cotton.
- 11. Preparing weekly weather and crop prospect reports in respect of cotton in all states and all crops in nodal states for review at the national level i.e. to Department of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare.
- 12. Build up state wise & district wise area, production & productivity data on Cotton;
- 13. To assist Department of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare in fixing targets of production and suggest measures to achieve them;
- 14. To help states in formulation of specific contingent plan;
- 15. To represent Central team in the event of natural disaster;
- 16. To organize and coordinate Seminar/Workshop/Conference /Review Meetings at state and national level.
- 17. To function as "Area Officers" to the Assigned States.
